Add a Security Bar or Rod

This creates a physical barricade that helps to prevent the door from sliding open, even if the lock is adjusted. Wooden rods, metal bars, or other types of security bars can be placed in the track to hinder sliding movement.

When going for this method, keep in mind that the bar fits properly and cannot be easily drawn out. Some adjustable bar models come with anti-lift locks for extra protection, giving you a powerful, low-cost deterrent against break-ins.

Install a Shatterproof Security Film

To fight this, consider installing unbreakable security window screens. These transparent layers are pasted directly to the glass and are perfectly made to hold shattered pieces of glass together in case of impact.

Secure the Door Tracks

It can also install anti-lift devices, which are small fasteners that sit at the top of the door frame and restrict how far a door can be pushed up or down.
